Discussion regarding the criteria that needs to be met in order for the school to obtain Title 1 status, application for families to apply for free-reduced lunch.

- a. SAGE Data-Alison Williams reviewed 6th/7th SAGE Data for 2016/2017. Data comparing Harris to 20 similar schools in proficiency/MGP was presented to the council. Discussion was held regarding SAGE test and discrepancy between proficiency in Science, Math, and Language Arts, state goal vs. actual scores. Alison introduced changes in WIN program to council which will hopefully lead to an increase in SAGE scores.
- b. Office Referral Data-Alison reviewed Office Referral data over the previous 5 years and informed the council of the Citizenship Awards program (\$10 gift cards, T-shirts, candy bars). Ladies and Gentleman's Week scheduled for second week in December.
- c. WIN Ticket Data-WIN ticket data for the previous year was reviewed.

- d. School Climate Survey-Survey to be given to students regarding whether they feel safe in classroom, does student feel like teacher knows the content, do they try hard in their classes, etc.

- a. Counseling-Just finished a 6-week friendship group for girls which was successful. Counselors will now be doing small group PCCRs for 7th graders and parents. The district has had 53 suicide threats, attempts, or completions so far this school year. Harris has had 1 attempt and 6 threats of suicide since September. Resources include BRMH, which comes into the school, Boys and Girls Club runs some groups, and private counselors. SafeUtah App and Hope Squad is also available in the school as well.
